Our Commitment to the Environment

Atholl Estates will be planting approximately 1.5 million trees in new native woodland creation over the next three years. We have restored over 90,000m of drained peatland and repaired over 70 hectares of eroded peat. We plan to restore over 100 hectares every year for the next 5 years.

Our farms are focused on high welfare native breeds and are leading the way in regenerative farming practices which increase biodiversity, improve soil health and sequester carbon.

Often planted as boundary lines around areas like farm fields or gardens, hedges are much more than useful dividers. Culturally and historically important, they are teeming with life, provide landscape-scale connectivity and make an immense contribution to halting biodiversity decline and tackling climate change. It's estimated that 40% of UK hedges (95,000 miles) are ancient and or species rich.
